Erasmus+

Student Mobility for Studies (KA131) is part of the Erasmus+ 2021/2027 programme Action 1.

This Call allows students to undertake a period of international mobility during their 1st, 2nd or 3rd study cycle at a Partner University that has signed a bilateral agreement with the University of Turin.

Students can:

- take courses and exams;
- combine study with an internship or research for thesis;
- undertake PhD research.

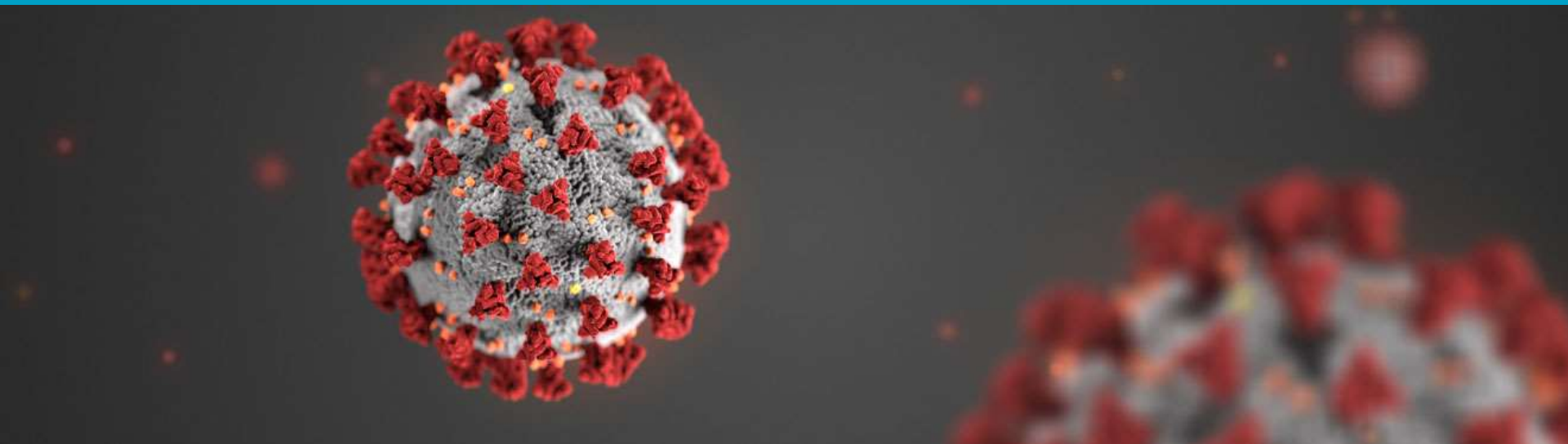


Erasmus+

Partner Universities that are in one of the following two country groups:

- **Programme Countries including:** EU Member States, EEA countries (Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway), acceding countries, candidate countries and potential candidates (Turkey, Serbia and the Republic of North Macedonia);
- **Partner Countries including:** all countries not part of Programme Countries group. **NB UK and Switzerland are in this group.**

Students enrolled at the University of Turin, but not resident in Italy, cannot carry out a mobility in a Partner University in their own country of residence.



Candidates are also required to find out about the exceptional COVID-19 provisions introduced by the European Commission (2020) and detailed in this Call in Annex II

2. Confirmed dissertation research (1 ects)

C. Supplementary EU funding for students with special needs

TYPE 1: TRAVEL GRANT (depending on the 2021 ISEE) **NEW!**

- is a recognised one-off amount for a two-way journey
 - will be recognised and paid at the end of the mobility
 - varies based on EU defined kilometre range and travel type ("standard" or "green")
-
- **"Standard" Travel Grant** For those who use standard means of transport (e.g. flights) to reach their Erasmus destination, with variable amounts *(Table No. 7 – KILOMETRE RANGE)*
 - **"Green" Travel Grant** For those who use means of transport with low environmental impact (e.g. train, car sharing, bus, etc.) in order to reach their Erasmus destination. *(Table No. 8)*

TYPE 2: TOP UP TRAVEL GREEN (no ISEE) **NEW!**

- A. TOP UP Travel Green** is a travel fund for Erasmus Mobility for Studies a.y. 2022/2023 beneficiaries (students) who make an **environmentally friendly journey** to their destination and who DO NOT receive "TRAVEL GRANT" funds referred to in Type 1.

EXCEPTION 1: EQUIVALENT STUDENTS (TO ISEE VALUE UNDER €13,000)

- a disability 50% or more
- refugees status
- subsidiary protection status
- Italian Government scholarship holder

Students in these categories **DO NOT** need to present any ISEE/ISEE parificato for this Call.

EXCEPTIONS 2 and 3

- students exempted from University fees
- EDISU scholarship holder for l'a.y. 2021/2022

WARNING:

Those who meet the criteria in **EXCEPTION 2 and 3** can send to the International Mobility Office at internationalexchange@unito.it a copy of the ISEE/ISEE parificato for the year 2022 from 1st Jan 2022 and no later than **31st May 2022**

7.5 – PAYMENT METHODS AND TIMING

First payment

- During the first month (100% **A**) + (70% **B** according to the economic requirement)

Second payment

- At the end of the semester: 30% **B** + TRAVEL GRANT or TOP-UP Travel Green, if applicable

Waiver / The student has to return the entire amount received if:

- the student renounces to the Erasmus experience
- the student stays less than 60 days abroad
- UniTO cancels the mobility due to a student's failure to comply with the obligations of the mobility contract they have signed

The student has to return part of the amount received if :

- the student stays less than the period agreed by the Bilateral Agreement
- the credits recognised by UniTO are less than 2 EU credits per month
- the credits recognised by UniTO are less than 1 EU credit for dissertation research

This Call mobility scholarship is:

- **COMPATIBLE** with other scholarships and/or grants from other funding bodies and/or scholarship providers, although the beneficiary (student) must check with them about the compatibility of Erasmus+ funding with any other funding claimed/received. The International Mobility Office does not have this information, so students must contact the relevant organisations themselves;
- **INCOMPATIBLE** with additional EU funds granted for the same purpose, namely to support international mobility.

Registration exams:

Winner of the 1st ranking:

Students will be ranked from the highest to the lowest depending on their scores and considering – if possible – the destinations they chose.

Students who do not win a place will be given a reserved position on the list.

Eligible student:

After the acceptance or waiver the eligible applicant will be assigned to the destination of their choice, if available.

Eligible students for the 2nd ranking:

Applicant meet the call requirements, but due to the lack of places in the destination choices, the student will be assigned to the 2nd ranking.

The Interuniversity office will assign students places taking into consideration their choice of linguistic area.
