Based on the specific criteria indicated in the call for proposals, the Commission has decided to use an evaluation grid (Attachment 1 - Evaluation Grid) that allows comparative evaluation based on the **validity**, **consistency** and **content** of the project, giving priority to the following themes: environmental sustainability, social sustainability, inclusion and governance (ESG), circular economy, internationalization and digital transformation.

The score is awarded based on the following values:

PLANNING ABILITY (max. **35** points)

- Originality of the project 0-10
- Effectiveness of communication 0-10
- Elaboration skills 0-10
- Relevance to priority themes 0-5

INTERNSHIP (max. **10** points)

- Absence/presence of internship 0-5
- Ambition and motivation 0-5

SCHOOL MERIT (max. **5** points)

- Marks average 0-5

totalling **50 points**.

The Commission has evaluated eligible candidates those who have scored at least 26 total points.
